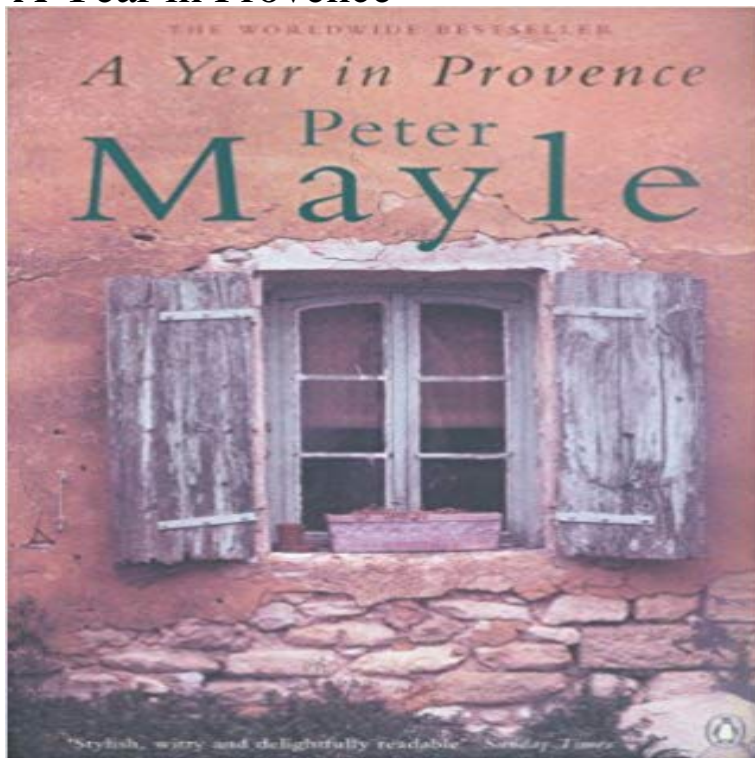


## A Year in Provence
