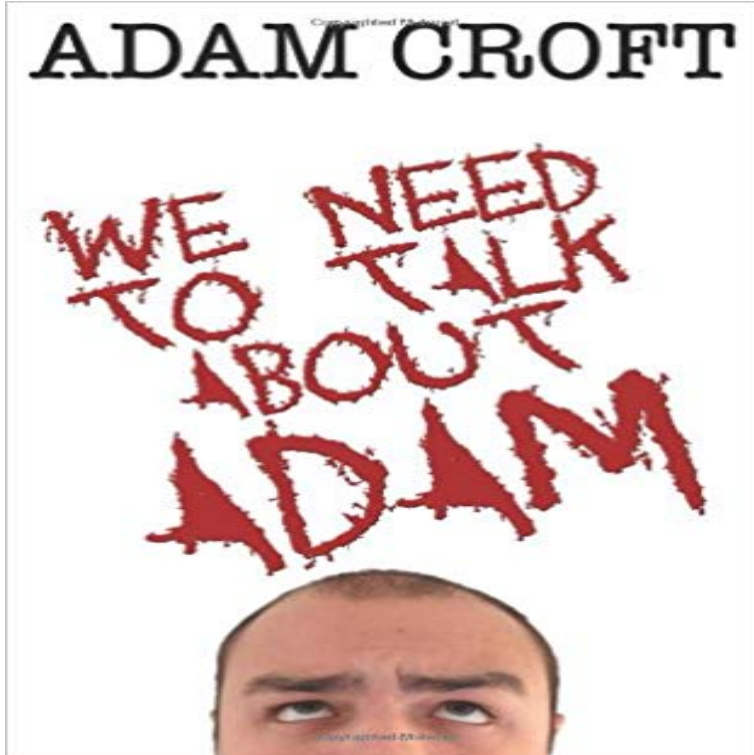


We Need to Talk About Adam
