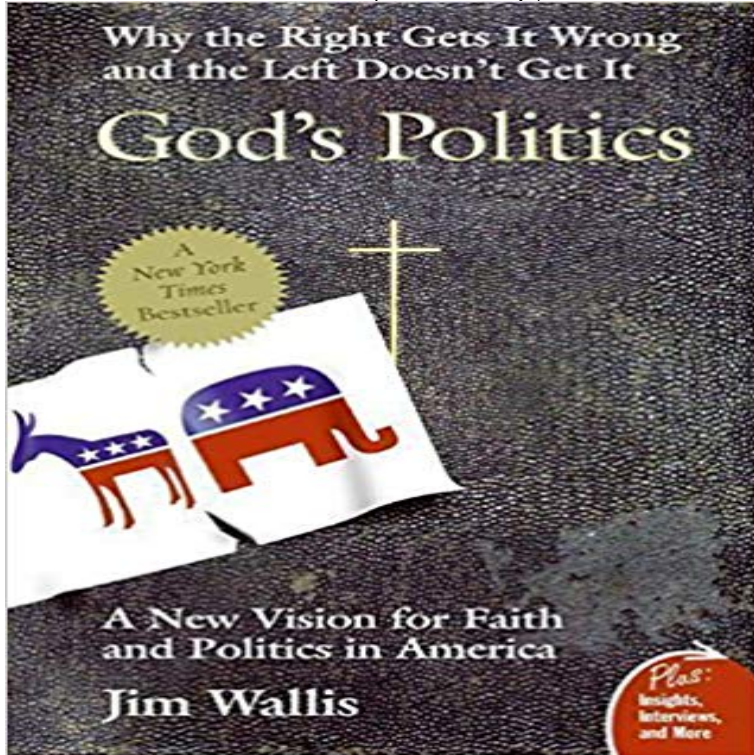


Gods Politics: Why the Right Gets It Wrong and the Left Doesn't Get It
