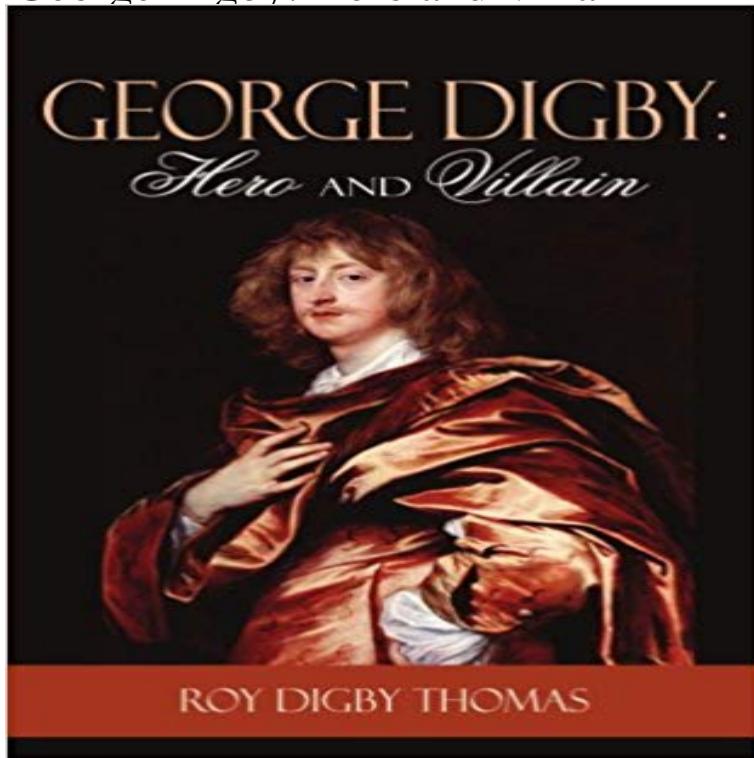


## George Digby: Hero and Villain
