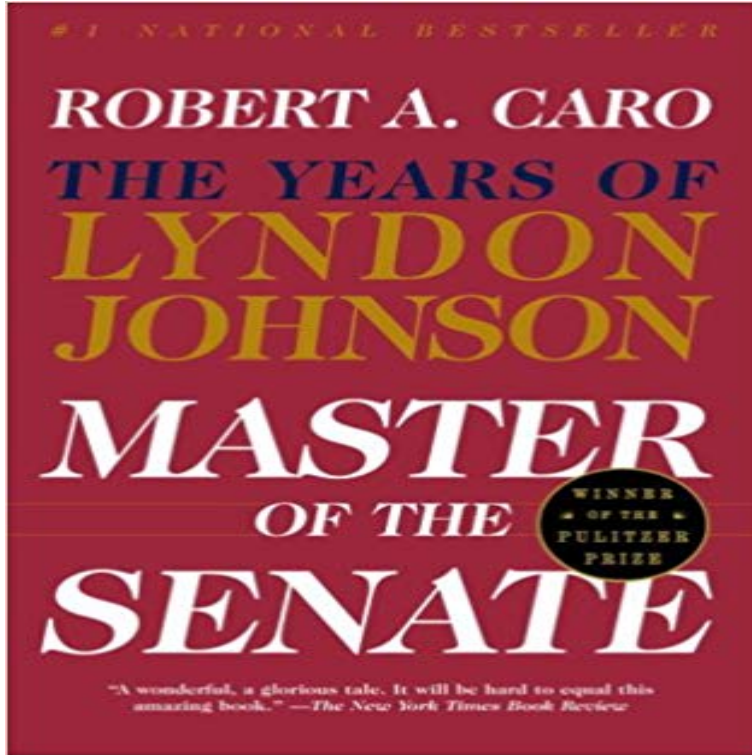


# Master Of The Senate: The Years of Lyndon Johnson
