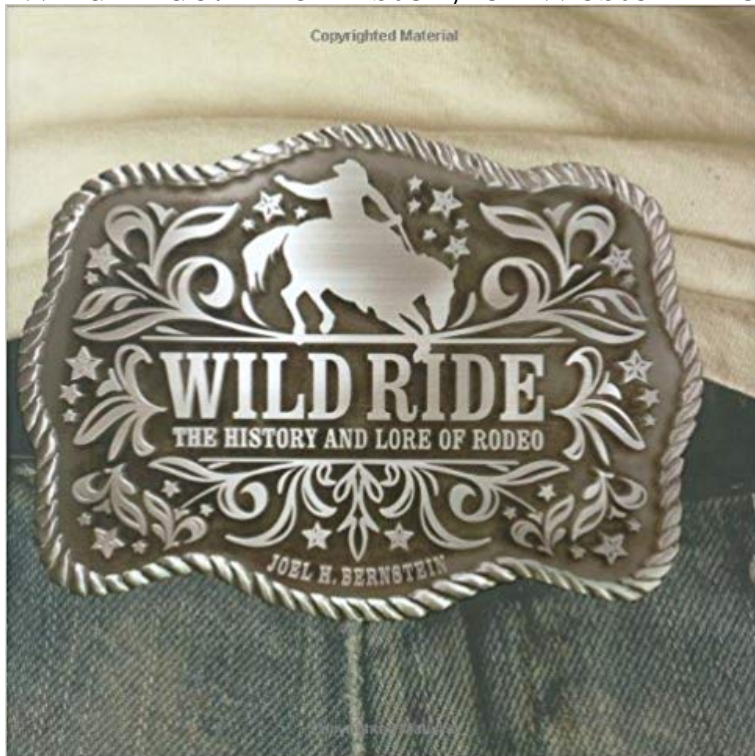


Wild Ride: The History of Western Rodeo
