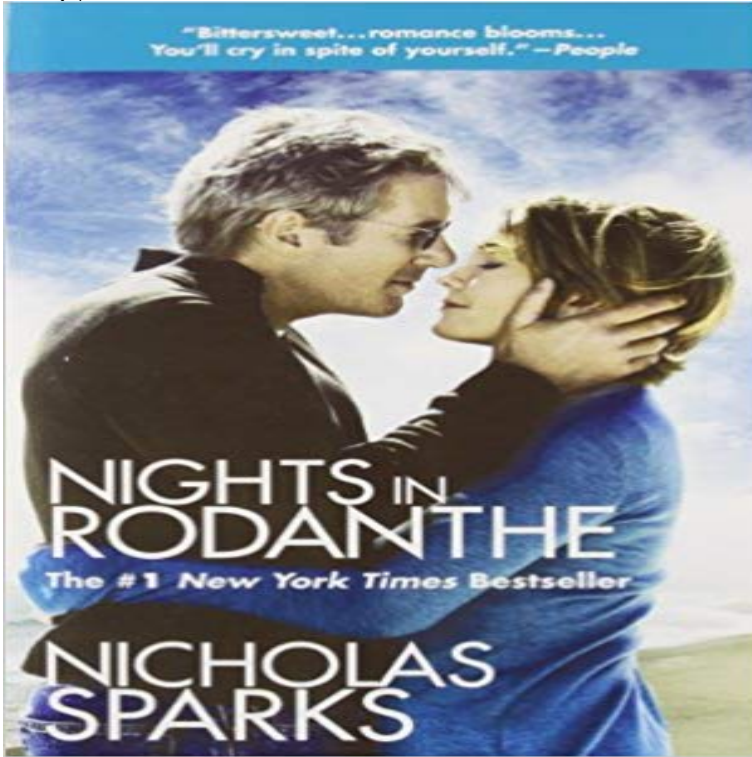


Nights in Rodanthe
