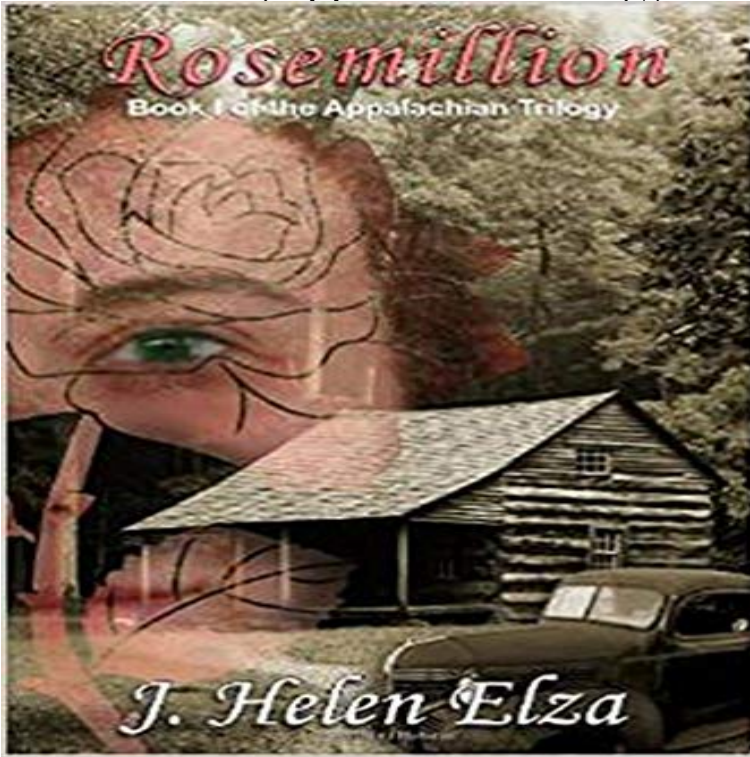


## Rosemillion (Appalachian Trilogy Book 1)
