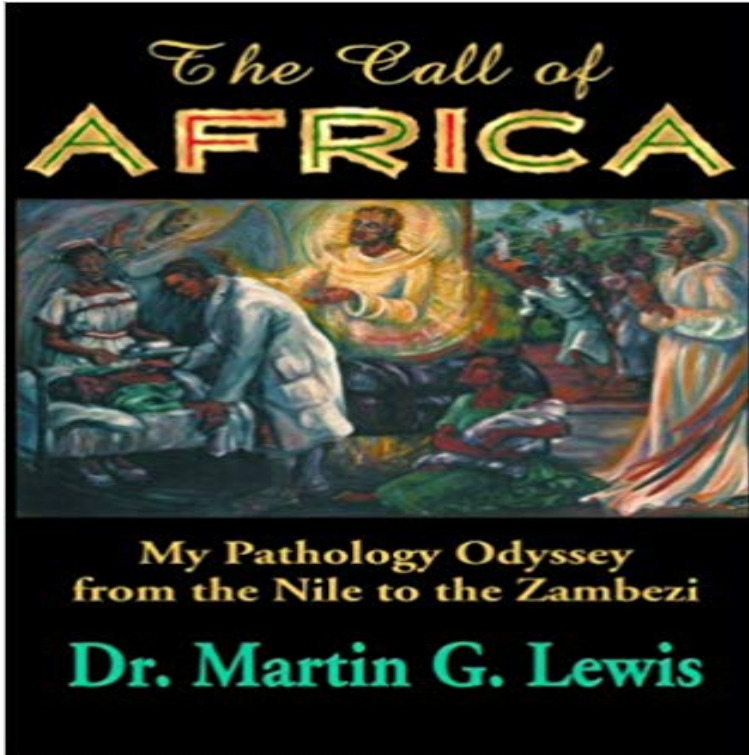


The Call of Africa
