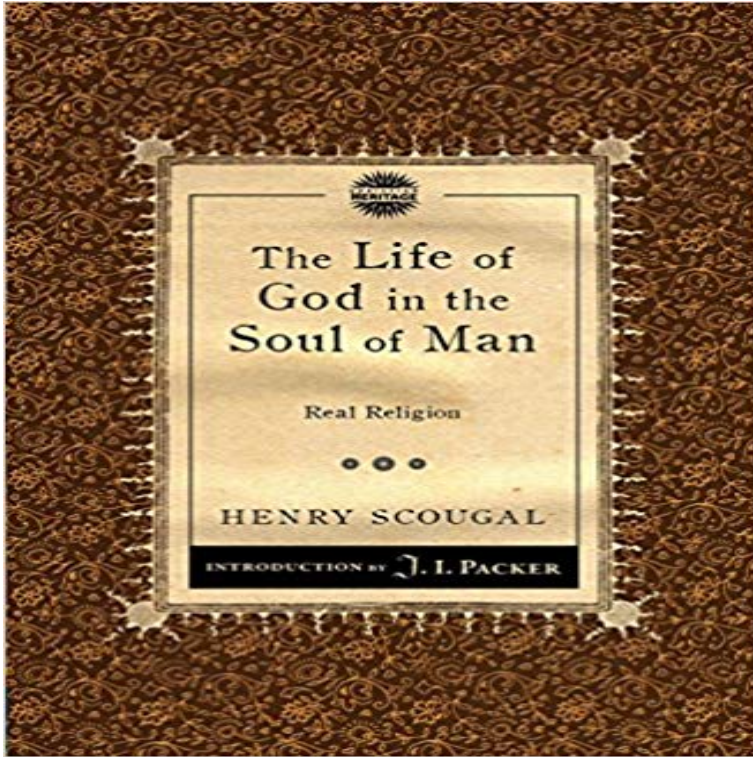


The Life of God in the Soul of Man: Real Religion
