

The Dhammapada is a versified Buddhist scripture traditionally ascribed to the Buddha himself. It is one of the best-known texts from the Theravada canon. The title, Dhammapada, is a compound term composed of dhamma and pada, each word having a number of denotations and connotations. Generally, dhamma can refer to the Buddha's doctrine or an eternal truth or righteousness or all phenomena; and, at its root, pada means foot and thus by extension, especially in this context, means either path or verse or both. The Dhammapada contains 423 verses in 26 chapters mostly dealing with ethics.
