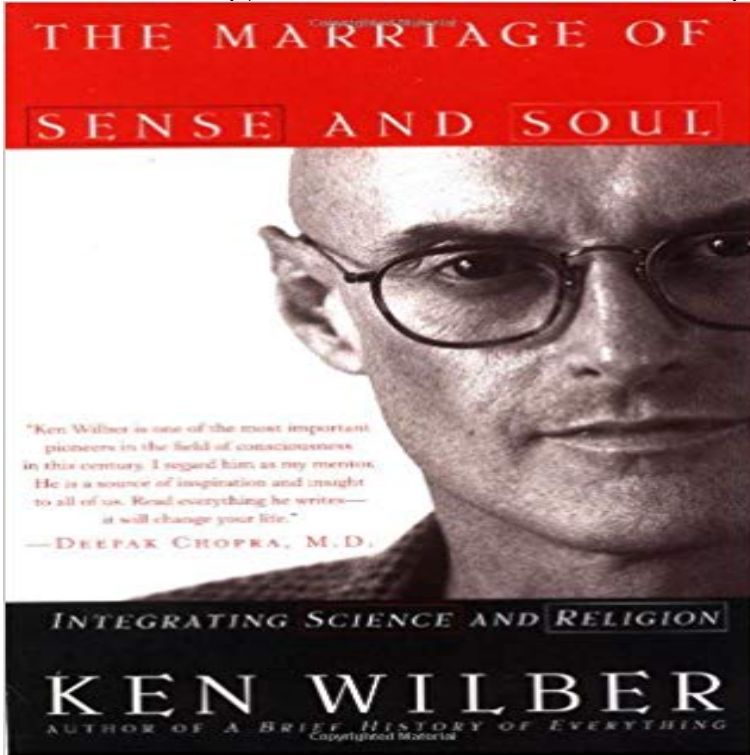


The Marriage of Sense and Soul: Integrating Science and Religion
