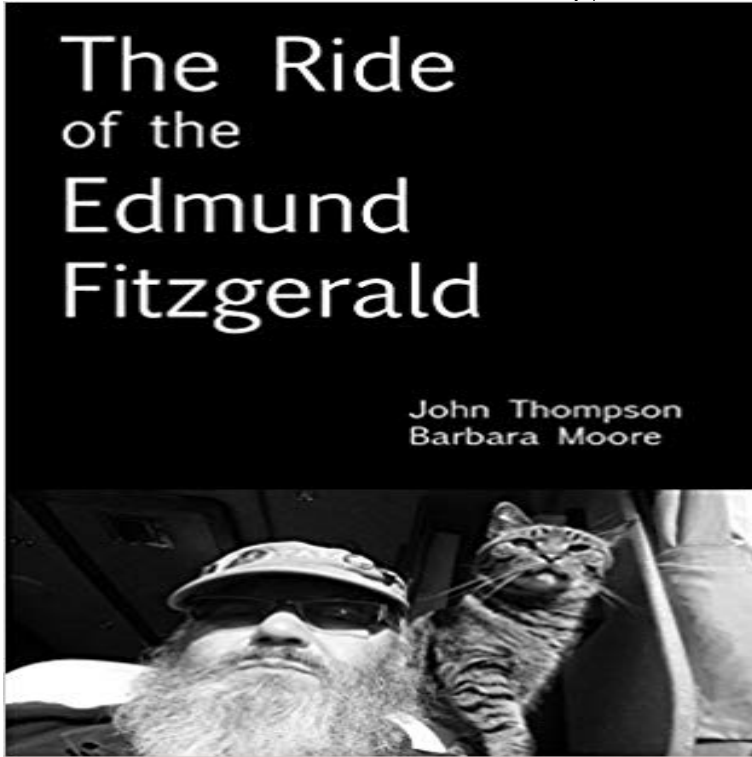


The Ride of the Edmund Fitzgerald
