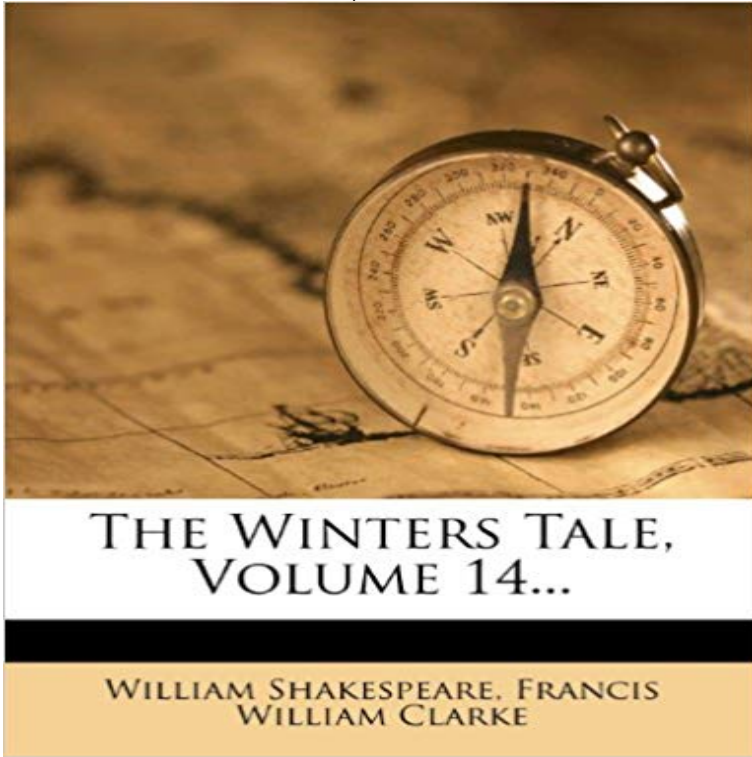


# The Winters Tale, Volume 14...
