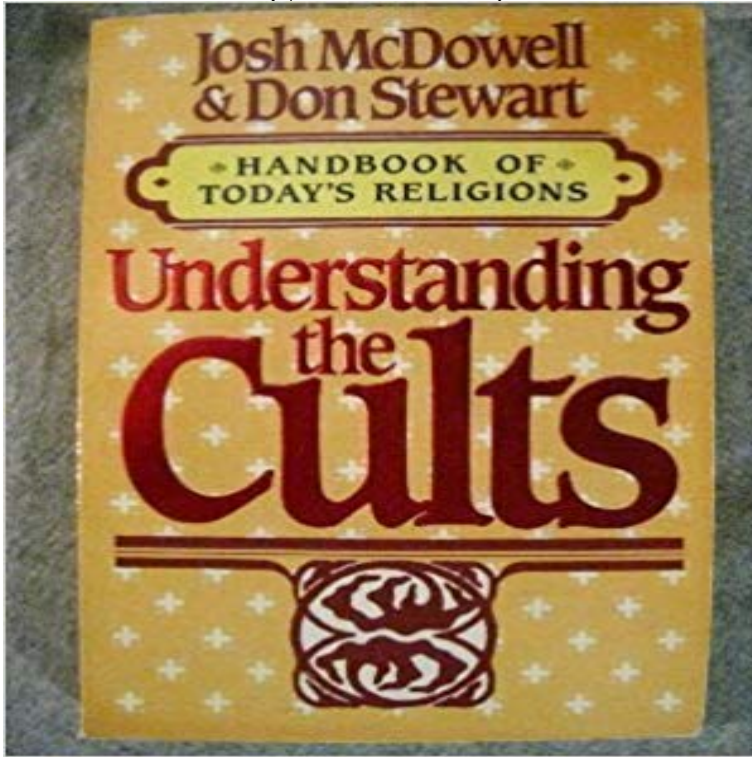


Understanding the Cults (Handbook of Today's Religions)

Any adherent to the above groups should honestly evaluate how their beliefs contradict Christianity and consider truth as revealed by Gods Holy Bible. The true believer will benefit by understanding what the people of these groups believe and how they can communicate with them over religious matters.
